INFORMATION SHIPMENT
(LE HAVRE – November 25th and 26th 2009)

Access to the Port :

At the entree of the Port (Roulier terminal) :

- You must show your passport and registration cards.
- You must show the private Pass confirmed.

Opening hours :

Wednesday, November 25th 2009 – 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.
Thursday, November 26th 2009 - 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.

No vehicles will enter the Parc Fermé after this hour.

You must present your vehicle with the **brackets and connections of the safety materials already fixed (Iritrack, Etrack, GPS, Sentinel, Tripy)**, the Iritrack and the Sentinel directly connected to the battery.

The motorbikers could load their stuff on their **trunks** and leave their **wheels** (same procedure as Dakar 2009 – **Delivery place : Hangar 122 – Terminal de l'Océan**)

State of vehicle :

- Check your tires
- Check the doors are closed

« **Motorcyclists, empty your tanks** »

« **Assistances, empty your gas bottles and petrol** »

Height Limitations :

Cars : 2.10 m
Trucks : 4.00 m

Do not stock anything on the rack roof of your vehicles

Personal effects :

Do not leave anything inside the vehicle

Transport of goods :

- Be careful about locking your vehicle
- Respect transport rules about prohibited goods (Tobacco, Alcohol...)

The **collection of the vehicles in Argentina** (Delta Dock Terminal in ZARATE City – same as Dakar 2009) will take place on **December 28th and 29th.**

PROCEDURE

You must drive your own vehicle to the port of LE HAVRE. **Each vehicle must be taken in charge at least by one person who knows it.**

In order to have access to this area, you must show the convocation.

1 ► Please show the vehicle official registration documents to the ASO's representative and Port Authorities.

A.S.O. representative will give you the documents to fill in and to be returned signed to the **« administrative » bungalow.**

2 ► **Safety equipments set up**

3 ► A contractual report concerning the state of the vehicle will be carried out in your presence by an expert.

34 ► Once your vehicle is parked, please fill in the document with the **instructions for starting-up your vehicle**, that you will hand over to the ASO representative.

5 ► Once you have finished these things you must pass at bungalows :

- **Customs : Delivery of your materials packing list**
- **Administrative forms**

6 ► Hand over the keys and signed document at the « Administrative » (administrative formalities) bungalow.

The vehicles will be placed in a park protected and watched over by the port police and a private security company until the boat leaves the port.

All customs formalities for competitors in LE HAVRE and in BUENOS AIRES (DELTA DOCK) will be undertaken by the organisation.

The vehicles will be loaded in LE HAVRE and unloaded in the port of DELTA DOCK by an ASO team.

INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

In application of the Lahaye-Visby regulations, A.S.O.'s liability is strictly limited. The maximum compensation cannot exceed 666.67 DTS per vehicle or 2 DTS per kilo (gross weight) for any loss or damaged goods, the most favourable to the demanding party being applicable.

It hence befalls the competitor and / or owner and / or keeper of any transported vehicle who deems the limitation to be unsatisfactory to subscribe at his own expense to any additional insurance guarantee.

One DTS (Special Draw Right) = 1.31US dollar on October 12th
